

GLEANING RULES

1. **When gleaning, remember you are on another person's land.** Treat it better than you treat your own property. We are guests; don't abuse the privilege, or we may lose it.
2. **Respect the food.** Remember someone will be eating it. Don't throw it or have food fights.
3. **Glean only** in designated areas.
4. **Safety is of utmost importance in gleaning. If any activity is of questionable safety, do not do it.** Be sure to avoid climbing trees or fences, riding on the back of moving trucks, and working near farm machinery.
5. Children 12 and under must be closely supervised by parents or other responsible adults.

HELPFUL HINTS FOR GLEANING

1. Dress in layers. In the mornings, it is often cool and wet; long-sleeved shirts and long pants are usually most comfortable. As it gets warmer, shorts and short sleeve shirts may be better (you may want to put these on under your other clothes).
2. Wear gloves and a hat.
3. Bathroom facilities are unavailable in most gleaning fields, so use facilities before coming to the farm.
4. Anyone with allergies, particularly reactions to bee stings or poison ivy should tell the gleaning coordinator.

DIRECTIONS TO SYCAMORE SPRING ORCHARD

FROM I-81

Take I-81 N to Rte 934 South (exit 85A), proceed 1/8th of a mile.
Turn left onto Rte 22 (go East).
Turn right onto Rte 72 (go South).
Stay on Rte 72 and go past Frogs Hollow Tavern on the right side.
Turn right onto first street, called Thompson Ave.
After 1½ mile, the orchard is on the right side.
Turn right and follow the orange cones.

FROM CITY OF LEBANON

Rte 72 N and go past Heisey's Diner on the right side.
Turn left onto Heilmandale.
After 3½ miles of curves, the orchard is on the far right side at the Thompson Ave intersection.
Go straight and follow the orange cones.

FROM SQUARE IN ANNVILLE

If coming from Palmyra, at stop light in Annville, turn left
If coming from Lebanon/Cleona, at stop light in Annville, turn right

Go ~1 mile, turn right onto Hill Church Rd (heading East)
At second road (first one is a quickie), turn left onto Thompson Ave (heading North)
Go ~3-5 miles, the orchard and fruit stand will be on the left side
Turn left onto Heilmandale Rd
Go back to the orchard and follow the orange cones.
